MARCH 2005 – UPDATE

Objectives

The core objective is to provide a global effort to promote and enhance the profile and recognition of Toxicologists worldwide; particularly:

- ✓ the development of criteria for recognizing qualified toxicologists
- ✓ to assist Member Societies and Associate Members in establishing these criteria, using them in the recognition of toxicologists worldwide
- ✓ to promote identification of education and training needs to enhance expertise in toxicology worldwide.

Moreover, the management of a persistent contact with other IUTOX Committees - Education and Career (E&CC), Developing Countries (DCC) and Communication (CC) mainly - for cross activities.

The **Specific Objectives** for **2004 - 2007** are:

- To implement Center of Establishment (CoE), Geo spread, as reference for toxicologists in each geo area to gather information to support and reach an harmonized procedure for qualified Toxicologists
- To define "The Templates" (former Strawmen) and share it more widely as guidelines to CoEs as well as to toxicologists for their professional development
- To enhance Web information, as main and key tool for communication and fundamental support for the achievement of the other objectives
- To stimulate and facilitate registration for "toxicologists" at the existing Registers and boards WW, even cross countries
