The World Academy of Sciences for the Advancement of Science in Developing countries Young Affiliates Network (TYAN) met for its 3rd TYAN International Thematic Workshop in Monastir, Tunisia, on November 04-06, 2019. This group was established in 2016 during the 27th TWAS Annual General Meeting with the aim of uniting the voices of young scientists and serving as a platform for international collaboration. One of the themes of the meeting was addressing global challenges with the vision of “a world connected by scientific cooperation.”

About 50 young scientists representing 26 countries from four TWAS regional partners attended The Thematic Workshop. The workshop was jointly organized by the Tunisian Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research (MES), Monastir and Jendouba Universities the Tunisian Society of Psycho-Neuro-Endocrino-Immunology (AT-PNEI), the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ISESCO), the Commission on Science and Technology for Sustainable Development in the South (COMSATS), the Inter Islamic Network on Information Technology (INIT), The World Academy of Sciences for the Advancement of Science in Developing countries (TWAS), TWAS Young affiliates Network (TYAN), in partnership with the TWAS Arab Regional Partner (TWAS-AREP) and TWAS Sub-Saharan Africa Regional Partner (TWAS-SAREP). It was held in Monastir, Tunisia.

The workshop was included 35 presentations by the TWAS Young Affiliates Network and presenters from the ISESCO, COMSATS and INIT. During the workshop round tables were held to enhance collaborative project between young Scientists in the same field of research (good scientific idea to be developed with limited resources).
