

## **Brief CV for A P Adam H Woolley, MSc, DABT, FRCPath, ERT, Fellow ATS**

### **1. Summary:**

A professional toxicologist, with American and European certification, I have more than 40 years' experience including 18 in contract research and nine in the pharmaceutical industry, followed by 17 years as a consultant for ForthTox. While in contract, I was responsible for studies with agrochemicals, pharmaceuticals and industrial chemicals. I have conducted numerous general toxicity studies and reviewed reports and data packages containing a broad spectrum of study types, which have required interpretative knowledge of pathology and mechanisms of toxicity and their relevance to man.

From my first involvement with the Education Sub-committee of the British Toxicology Society (BTS), I have been much involved with education in toxicology, and have been a speaker on MSc programmes in the UK at Surry University, Aberdeen, and Queen Mary University London. In addition, I have been a presenter on several occasions on a course run by the American College of Toxicology (ACT) in collaboration with the BTS in the UK: *Practical Application of Toxicology in Drug Development*. I have also initiated a continuing education session at ACT on the Use and misuse of statistics in toxicology (ACT meeting, 2016) and a symposium – "4 M's: Mistakes, Misuse, Mismanagement, Misunderstanding...Looking at Things That Have Gone Wrong in the Past: What to Learn to Plan for the Future" was given at the ACT meeting in 2013.

I was also the initiator for the Basic Training in Toxicology e-webinars, sponsored by ACT and BTS, which ran successfully in 2016/2017; I am Chair of the committee tasked with continuing this initiative in the next 12-18 months.

During my career I have sat on numerous committees (see below) principally for the BTS but also for the American Board of Toxicology and for the American College of Toxicology and for the Royal College of Pathologists, where I was chair of the panel of toxicology examiners for several years.

I am on the editorial boards of the International Journal of Toxicology and of Toxicology Reports. I am the author of the first two editions of *A Guide to Practical Toxicology: evaluation, prediction and risk* (Taylor and Francis; InformaHealthcare, 2003/2008) and the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition, written with David Woolley, published by Taylor and Francis, (2017).
